She continues to be involved in the psychological and neuropsychological evaluations of children 6 months to 18 years of age and the supervision and training of Master's level professionals, graduate students, and to be involved in the coordination of care with in our section. Mary Ann is also interested in intervention and is active in developing intervention services in the community and in building school and pre-school collaboration.
