Students who complete their 2-year **Associate of Arts in Teaching (AAT)** degree at an Arkansas community college can transfer to the University of Arkansas and earn their:

BSE degree and K-6 teacher's license in 2 years
OR
BSE, Master of Arts in Teaching degree, K-6 teacher's license and area endorsement* in 3 years
